THIS MATTER having come before the court on the debtors' Voluntary Motion to Dismiss, Docket #86. The time has passed for the creditors and other interested parties to object.

In light of the recent memorandum decision by the Honorable Joseph M. Meier, Chief U.S. Bankruptcy Judge, in the case of *In re Evans and Steedham*, Case # 19-40193-JMM, entered on February 13, 2020, Docket #40, and Order Sustaining Objection to Trustee's Final Report, Docket #41, and Section 1326 (a)(2), of the United States Bankruptcy Code, the Court hereby orders and directs the Chapter 13 Trustee to return all payments to the Debtors and that the Trustee shall not retain a percentage fee where the case has not been confirmed.
