Prescription Drug Monitoring Program (PDMP)
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The Idaho Division of Occupational and Professional Licenses is launching a new system for authorized drug distributors to report monthly prescription drug (including controlled substances) sales to Idaho practitioners, called the **Idaho Practitioner Sales Reporting System**.

According to the Idaho Board of Pharmacy Administrative rules, an authorized Drug Distributor must submit drug distribution data monthly, in a format specified by the Division.

This communication affects the following (authorized Drug Distributors) licensees:

- Manufacturer
- Wholesale Distributor – to include Virtual
- Resident and Non-Resident Drug Outlet

Registration must be completed by **July 1, 2024**.

Beginning August 1st, 2024, reports must be submitted in ARCOS format via Secure FTP, Web Portal Upload, or Manual Entry (UFC) for the previous month.

To satisfy reporting requirements please submit one of the following:

- Sales to practitioners require a **Data Submission**
- No sales to practitioners require a **Zero Report**.

Third-Party Logistic Providers (3PL): Idaho licensees who sell prescription drugs shipped through a 3PL are considered the product owners and are responsible for reporting sales, not the 3PL.
