Your outline should contain:

- dates the project was initiated and completed
- business problem and solution
- significance and benefits of the project
- which category is best aligned with your project

Winners will expand their outline during May into a full nomination for submitting to NASCIO by June 4.

#### Eligibility

- With the exception of Fast Track Solutions, all projects must have been completed by December 1, 2011, and initiated no earlier than December 1, 2009.
- The nominated project must be able to stand on its own. If the initiative is a phase of a larger project, only the benefits of the phase can be recognized.
- Outsourced projects will be considered as long as they are managed and controlled by the state.
- The project must be state focused (not regional, local or national).
